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What is DetermaRx?

Every cancer is unique

DetermaRx is a test ordered by your doctor to provide more information about your individual lung cancer. The test analyzes the genes in your tumor to classify your cancer as having a low-, intermediate-, or high-risk of returning. Together, you and your doctor can use this information to design a treatment plan that is personalized to you.



Surgery is not always enough

Even after surgical removal of early-stage lung cancer, it is thought that cancer will return for **30-50% of patients**.¹ **DetermaRx** provides a means of assessing how likely it is that your cancer will come back after surgery. The test has been validated in multiple studies to identify patients with stage I-IIA non-squamous non-small cell lung cancer that are at higher risk for disease recurrence and therefore most likely to benefit from adjuvant chemotherapy.²⁻⁴



After your surgery, a sample of your tumor will be sent to Oncocyte's certified laboratory.



Results will be sent to your doctor about two weeks after our lab receives your sample.



Your doctor will review your results with you during a post-surgery follow-up visit.
